A **PRONOUN** is a word that can take the place of a noun.

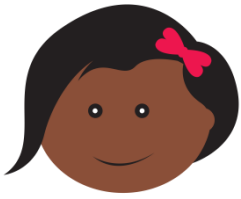
A **VERB** is an action word.

A **NOUN** is a person,
place or thing.

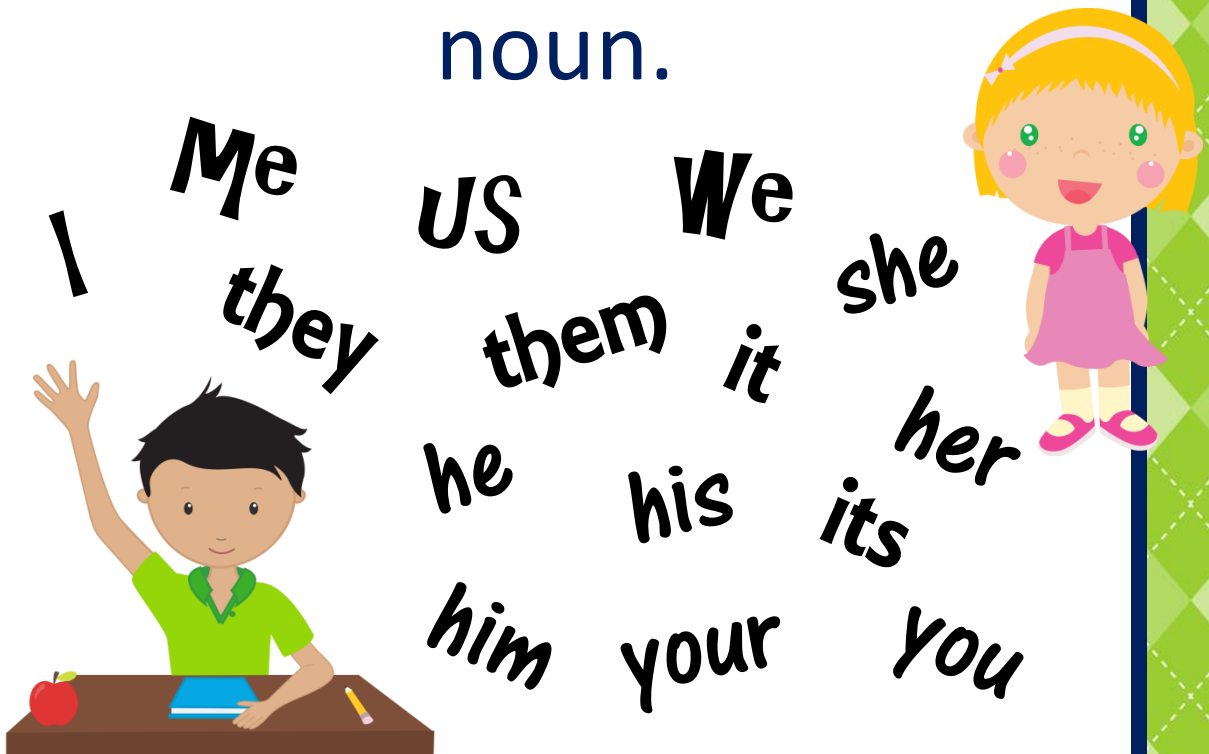


teacher friend chef

Ex: My **uncle** and I went to the
school to pick up my **backpack**,
book and **trumpet**.

PRONOUNS

A **PRONOUN** is a word that can take the place of a noun.



Ex: **I** hope that **we** can go with **him** to the basketball game and **he** will sit with **us**.



VERBS



A **VERB** is an action word.

kick sit talk sleep

jump catch play

write read Make throw

do Sleep wash climb

Spin Have ride

swim Save Learn



Ex: At home I **have** to **make** my bed, **take** out the trash, **do** my homework, **cook** dinner and **play** with my little brother.

ADJECTIVES

An **ADJECTIVE** is a word that describes a noun.

(What kind? Which? How many?)

FUNNY *green* **fantastic** *yellow*
blue **careful** **Smart**
confusing *orange* **quiet**
hot **red** **SMALL** **brilliant**
 **big** **proud** **cute** **purple**

Ex: Did you see the **tall** giraffes, the **scary** tigers, the **crazy** monkeys, the **loud** birds and the **tiny** bats at the **amazing** zoo?

ADVERBS

An **ADVERB** is a word that describes a verb.

(How? When? Where?)

Ex: She told us to **slowly** and **quietly** walk through the door and then **carefully** sit in our seats.
