Dear Families,

As my letter stated Monday, we began keeping track of classroom behavior this week. A behavior report will be sent home every Friday. Please review this report with your child, sign it and return it to school. This will allow you to see how your child is doing in class. The students are getting used to being back in school so I have been lenient with numbers and have given many reminders. Students have been given at least two or three warnings before I recorded a behavior this week. I usually find that many behaviors are fixed once the first behavior report is sent home. If there is a problem and I feel like we need to do more than a weekly behavior report to help your child succeed, I will contact you when I think we need to try something new. If you are concerned, please feel free to email or call me with any questions. Please don't expect your child to always receive zero marks. They are second graders and earning a couple of marks a week is normal. If a child has multiple marks a day, please talk with them about what they can do differently. Please know that I do not have a classroom where students are required to sit and be silent. We move around a great deal and are engaged in centers often. Students who earned four marks or less this week received a reward in class today and will get to pick a prize from the prize box Monday when they return this report.
