

<u>Lesson</u>: Readers Keep Record of their Reading <u>Subject Area</u>: Reading <u>Common Core Standards</u>:

Supplies Needed:

- Reading logs and forms found at http://www.thecurriculumcorner.com/2012/06/19/independentreading-student-response-forms/ (We suggest beginning with a
 simple reading log, once students have mastered keeping record,
 move on to more complex logs.) Once you have chosen the form you
 will use, make enough copies for you and each student in your class.
- The Car Washing Street by Denise Lewis Patrick (or another read aloud of your choice)
- Individual student book bags or baskets

Procedure:

- Begin by reading aloud <u>The Car Washing Street</u> by Denise Lewis Patrick.
- When you have finished your read aloud, model how you would record your reading on your log. Hand out logs for each student.
- Students will get their books and begin independent reading time. They will record their reading on their log.
- When reading time is over, gather together and share reading logs.
 Discuss what was done well and what students need to do in order to improve.
- This lesson can be repeated throughout the year with each type of reading log.
