Katherine began attending West Virginia State College at the age of 15.

#### Spring 1937

Katherine graduated from college with a degree in mathematics and French.

#### Fall 1937

Katherine began teaching at a school in Marion, Virginia.

#### 1939

Katherine married James Francis Goble. They had three daughters.

#### 1953

Katherine was hired as a mathematician at NACA (National Committee for Aeronautics.) She was quickly transferred to the flight research division.

#### 1956

Katherine's husband died of a brain tumor.

#### 1958

NACA became NASA (National Aeronautics and Space Administration.)

#### 1959

Katherine married James Johnson.

### 1969

Katherine helped perform calculations when Apollo 11 traveled to the moon.

Katherine was responsible for plotting the path of Alan Shepard as he traveled into space.

#### 1970

Katherine was responsible for checking the computer's math for sending John Glenn around the earth.


