



January 3, 2009 Malala begins blogging about her life under the Taliban's rule.

July 24, 2009 Malala and her family return to their home.


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
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October 9, 2012 Malala is shot by a member of the Taliban on her way home from school. She makes a full recover. July 12, 2013 Malala speaks at the United Nations.

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

The Taliban did not allow girls to go to school in the Swat Valley.


Many schools were destroyed by the Taliban. Malala won Pakistan's first National Youth Award for Peace in 2011.




