#### Task #3 Make a Flip Book

### Task #4 Cause & Effect

- Cut around the outside edge of the shape and then fold the arrows in on the dotted lines.

- Then on the triangle shape just underneath the arrow (in the center of the book) write what caused that event to happen.
- Finally, close the arrows and sketch a picture of the events you chose on the outside.




