

All the animals stood in line to sit on Santa Bruce's lap and tell him what they wanted for Christmas.


All of the animals parents came over to thank Santa Bruce for his Christmas spirit.

Thistle announced that Santa Bruce would be delivering presents to all of the kids.


Bruce put his foot down and said he wouldn't deliver gifts, but his mice family convinced him.




