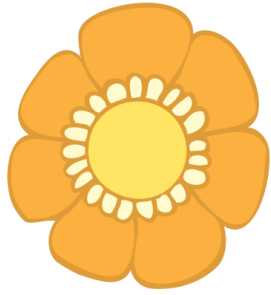


What Good Readers Do

 - Ask questions.
- Use pictures to help them understand what is happening.
 - Think about what they have read.
 - Refresh their memory from the day before by rereading a little bit.
