- Use reading strategies when they come to words they don't know.
 - Think about what they already know to help them understand.

 - Make predictions.
 - Ask questions.
 - Use pictures to help them understand what is happening.
 - Think about what they have read.
 - Refresh their memory from the day
 before by rereading a little bit.
