




Did you know that the largest snowman ever built was 122 feet, one inch tall in Bethel, Maine? Olympia was the snowwoman's name and she took around a month to build with the help of a crane. She was finished on February 26, 2008 and over 13 million pounds of snow were used to make her.





Did you know that snowflakes begin from crystals of ice that are formed from particles of dust, pollen or dirt in the air? Water vapor coats the particle and freezes into a tiny crystal. The particle becomes heavier than the air and begins to fall. As it falls more water vapor coats and freezes to the crystal becoming a snowflake. Each snowflake could have as many as 200 crystals in it!
