amphibian

an animal that can live both on land and in water

frog


an amphibian that lives mostly in water; has smooth wet skin and strong back legs

toad

an amphibian that lives mostly on land; has dry bumpy skin and strong back legs

cold-blooded

keeping a body temperature that is almost the same as the surrounding air



an oval or round object from which an amphibian is born

tadpole

a small creature that becomes an adult frog or toad; lives in the water and has a round body and a long tail

froglet

a young frog that has changed from a tadpole

herpetologist

a person who studies amphibians

webbed

an area of skin that is between the fingers or toes of an animal

camouflage

a color or shape that protects an animal from an attack by making it hard to see in the area around it
