

Vocabulary – Newspapers

advertisement	words and pictures shown in a newspaper to help sell a product or make an announcement
article	a piece of writing about a particular subject that is included in a newspaper
byline	the name of the writer of an article; appears above the article
caption/cutline	information to describe a photo in a newspaper
comic strip	a series of cartoon drawings in a newspaper that tell a story or part of a story
cut	a photo or illustration in a newspaper
editor	the person on a newspaper staff who edits (corrects/changes) writing when needed
editorial	an essay in a newspaper that gives the opinions of the newspaper's editors or publishers

feature	a high interest or important article written for a newspaper
graphic	a mix of words and artwork that helps to tell or explain a story
headline	the title given to a story in a newspaper
journalist	a person who writes or edits for any type of news medium
lead	the first few sentences in a news story; usually answers WHO, WHAT, WHEN & WHERE (sometimes WHY and HOW)
masthead	the name of a newspaper in special font on the front page of a newspaper
newspaper	a set of large sheets of paper that has news stories, information about current and local events and advertisements; folded together and sold daily or weekly
reporter	a person who writes the news stories for a newspaper
