Vocabulary - Amphibians

amphibian	an animal that can live both on land and in water
camouflage	a color or shape that protects an animal from attack by making it hard to see in the area around it
cold-blooded	keeping a body temperature that is almost the same as the surrounding air
egg	an oval or round object from which an amphibian is born
frog	an amphibian that lives mostly in water; has smooth wet skin and strong back legs
froglet	a young frog that has changed from a tadpole
herpetologist	a person who studies amphibians
tadpole	a small creature that becomes an adult frog or toad; lives in the water and has a round body and a long tail
toad	an amphibian that lives mostly on land; has dry bumpy skin and strong back legs
webbed	an area of skin that is between the fingers or toes of an animal
