<b>Common Word</b>	<b>More Descriptive Words You Might Want to Think About Using</b>
<b>good</b>	wonderful, cool, fantastic, awesome, great, super, excellent, amazing, stupendous, respectable, wholesome, decent
<b>bad</b>	corrupt, evil, wicked, immoral, cruel, harmful, damaging, unhealthy, remorseful
<b>happy</b>	glad, content, cheerful, joyful, ecstatic, delighted, jovial, pleased, in high spirits, on cloud nine
<b>sad</b>	unhappy, depressed, miserable, gloomy, sorrowful, melancholy, woeful, blue, down, forlorn
<b>mad</b>	angry, furious, livid, irate, fuming, annoyed, outraged, infuriated, enraged, up in arms
<b>nice</b>	kind, polite, considerate, friendly, courteous, warmhearted, enjoyable, pleasant, lovely, fine
<b>mean</b>	unkind, cruel, callous, nasty, malicious, uncaring
<b>big</b>	large, giant, huge, enormous, immense, gigantic, massive, whopping, extensive, vast, great, broad
<b>little</b>	small, petite, tiny, minute, miniature, pocket-sized, slight, insignificant, minor, trivial, unimportant
<b>walk</b>	stride, strut, stroll, amble, march, toddle, stagger, hobble, plod
<b>run</b>	dash, sprint, jog, scamper, scuttle, rush, scurry, bolt, dart, hurry, skip

<b>laugh</b>	<b>chuckle, giggle, snicker, cackle, chortle, hoot, express amusement, have hysterics, double up, rolling in the aisles, crack up</b>
<b>pretty</b>	<b>lovely, attractive, beautiful, cute, good-looking, appealing, nice-looking, glamorous, gorgeous, elegant</b>
<b>ugly</b>	<b>unattractive, hideous, unsightly, revolting, repulsive, menacing, threatening, dangerous, hostile, intimidating, nasty, violent</b>
<b>like</b>	<b>enjoy, adore, love, fond of, keen on, partial to, appreciate, admire</b>
<b>dislike</b>	<b>hate, detest, loathe, disapprove, abhor, have an aversion to, frown upon, find it objectionable</b>
<b>very</b>	<b>rather, extremely, awfully, incredibly, especially, enormously, extraordinarily, fantastically, truly, vastly, surely, exceedingly</b>
<b>jump</b>	<b>leap, hop, hurdle, vault, bounce, spring, skip, soar, fly, bound</b>
<b>said</b>	<b>spoke, uttered, declared, stated, cried, shouted, replied, exclaimed, answered, pronounced, articulated, disclosed, expressed, imparted, revealed, told, whispered, alleged, screamed, give away</b>
